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Course Description:

The course has a dual function. On the one hand, it will serve as a follow-up seminar for the 2170 *Present Day English 2.0. Descriptive Grammar* lecture series on the English Verb Phrase by further discussing and clarifying the most basic issues in the lecture material.

On the other hand, it will offer advanced practice both in the domains of English grammar covered by the lectures and in related areas (conditional sentences, the use of the subjunctive and reported speech).

The ratio of descriptive grammar points and advanced practice will be 30% vs. 70%.

Grading will be based on attendance, participation in discussions and two major (mid-term and end-of-the-term) tests. A student may miss *three classes* at most (for miscellaneous reasons, *including* illness or family problems).
