<p>The course explores the incredible richness of variation in English with the help of aural material, databases, corpora and dictionaries. Apart from introducing and exploring the concepts of English as a mother tongue, English as a second language, English as a foreign language, English-based pidgins and creoles, English as a lingua franca and the varieties of all the previously mentioned Englishes, linguistic ideologies connected to these concepts will be discussed, too. The course will also include an analysis of Euro English (i.e. English used in the EU), and the influence of English on other languages – first and foremost on the first language(s) of the participants in the course.</p>
