#### Course description:

**Ethics: learning the ethical aspects of the work of a psychologist.**

After becoming aware of the basic ethical principles by analysing specific cases, students learn about ethical problems related to psychological knowledge, psychological research and work in the applied field (e.g. professionalism, confidentiality, working conditions, communication, publications, public performance).

**Law: is an overview of the basic knowledge of substantive and procedural law related to the activity of psychologists and the operation of related legal institutions in Hungary.** Students will also learn the introductory knowledge of law related to practising their profession in the field of civil law, patient's rights, and students may gain insight into certain branches of law.
