**Course Description:**

A presentation is only successful when the presenter, moderator, and questioner work together. Therefore, in Modern Japanese II, students learn the terminology used by presenters, moderators, and interviewers to make a successful presentation. They also learn simple statistical analyses, such as the chi-square test and the T-test, which are commonly used in humanities research. Additionally, students learn the Japanese expressions required for data analysis and interpretation, and practice presentations involving data analysis. They also plan and organize presentations by external lecturers (native Japanese speakers).
