Planned Psychology MA in English

In 2024, our Psychology MA program will be starting with a specialization to community and intercultural psychology. This specialization has already been running for many years in the Hungarian program.

Building on a positive psychology approach, we focus on community development in our applied social psychology specialisation, which is characterised by a systems approach. We offer theoretical training and practical experience in three areas: family processes, organisational development and social inclusion. Our graduates are successful as psychology professionals in the social care system (e.g., as family support workers), in organisational development (e.g., as HR managers, trainers), in the school-educational environment (e.g., educational counselling) and in dealing with social issues, in interdisciplinary cooperation with other disciplines. Further studies in professional psychology (e.g., counselling, work and organisational psychology) and doctoral studies (at ELTE's PhD school and the forthcoming KRE doctoral programme) will provide a solid basis for further studies.
