



**4/2021. (III.05.)/R Rector's Order
on the amendment of 1/2021. (I.26.)/R Rector's Order**

1. § In line with Government Decree 484/2020 (10 November) on the second phase of protective measures applicable during the period of state of danger and on the basis of the information provided on 5 March 2021 by deputy state secretary for higher education, innovation and vocational training of the Ministry for Innovation and Technology, Dr. József Bódis on the immediate revocation of the permits for exemption from digital education it has become necessary to amend 1/2021. (I.26.)/R Rector's Order on distance (online) education in order to reduce epidemiological infection in the spring semester of the academic year 2020/2021 (hereinafter: 1/2021. (I.26.)/R Rector's Order).

2. § The second sentence of paragraph 3 of 1/2021. (I.26.)/R Rector's Order is repealed from 5 March 2021.

„3 § In the 2. (spring) semester of the academic year 2020/2021, the university continues its distance (online) education, therefore the lectures, seminars and practical courses should possibly be held online. ~~If the distance (online) teaching cannot be ensured, upon request of the lecturer, researcher or teacher, in highly justified cases, the dean of the faculty responsible for teaching of the given programmes – informing the rector – may permit teaching with personal presence.~~“

3. § With effect from 5 March 2021 I order the cancellation of the exceptional permits for in-person education issued by the dean of the faculty.

4. § The other parts of 1/2021. (I.26.)/R Rector's Order not affected by this amendment remain in force.

5. § This order enters into force on 5 March 2021 and becomes enforceable on the date of its entry into force.
